The lanes at Pin Palace were not ready for this event. Bowlero sent Head Mechanic from Mobile on week 3 of the tournament. By the end of the event machines worked a lot better.

Workers for the tournament were paid from the incoming expense money. Michael and I decided to pay them better then they usually get as this was a lot of work and time. Much appreciation to those that did a great job during this event. My pay will come once SBC releases it. All Financial receipts have been turned over to Ed Campbell. Checks will be on their way.

Up coming State Open: Scheduled for May 2-3, May 9-10, and May 16-17. Team will be at Bowl Madison Squad times are 9 and 12 each day. Doubles/Singles Squad times are 9 and 1:30 each day. Once again, we will need board members to work at both houses. Will need check-in, Brackets, 50/50 and score corrections. I will be making a list at the meeting so be ready to give me information on when you can work. John Campbell will take charge at Bowl Madison, and I will take charge at Redstone.

Up coming State Mixed: Scheduled for June 6-7, June 13-14 and June 20-21 at River City Lanes in Decatur. I will be in charge there. Will need Brackets, 50/50 and score corrections. Will also be signing up help at the meeting. Not as much of a work force for this one but will need help.

Hall of Fame: James Cagle and Michael Price were voted on to be inducted into the HUSBC Hall of Fame. Waiting on the last youth league to finish for Bowler of the Year and make presentation of list of names to Youth Committee for Youth Hall of Fame.

The Hall of Fame will be held at Bowl Madison again this year on July 11, 2026. The cost of space is \$500, we had a vote and dinner will be LawLers BBQ. We will eat at 5:30 and then have ceremony. Tickets for the dinner will be \$20 each.

Annual meeting will be held at Bowl Madison on July 11, 2026, at 4:30 prior to the Hall of Fame. As the meeting doesn't last very long Michael and I felt it would be plenty of time.

J Lavigne motioned to accept reports as given. Motion passed.

The board discussed not allowing other people to sign bowlers up for brackets during a tournament. After some discussion it was decided we would not allow another person to sign a bowler up for brackets. The bowler would have to do it.

It was asked if we could possibly do a ball raffle at our events. Michael Webber said he would check on cost and see if vendors would donate balls.

Michael discussed the upcoming State Open Tournament in May and that we would need volunteers at both Bowl Madison and Redstone for the 1st 3 weekends in May. Rhonda will send email out to have board sign up for shifts.

It was discussed that the expense fee to be received from the Southern Bowling Congress Tournament of \$4300 was in the most part given to the workers of the tournament in the amount of \$3080. Thus leaving \$1220 to be put in the general fund. All checks with the exception of those still waiting on 1099 information have been mailed to team captains. SBC has received copies of receipts and full financial report from the tournament.

The Youth Committee is meeting after the meeting to discuss the Youth Hall of Fame.

Meeting adjourned. Annual meeting will be July 11, 2026 at Bowl Madison time is 4:30 PM.
