New Business:

Bowler of the Month Committee: The committee presented a new plan for BOM for the 2016-2017 season. We will go to 2 categories, over all Bowler of the Month any age, male and female, and Senior BOM age 50 and over, male and female. Information will be turned in as before by league secretary. A list will be made and posted on web and facebook. In May the final list will be posted and the bowlers on it will receive a plaque at the Annual Meeting. Certificates will no longer be given each month, all bowlers will receive the same thing at the meeting. If a bowler sees their scores were not submitted the information will be checked out and changes to the list will be made.

M Webber made a motion to accept the proposal. Motion seconded and carried.

Hall of Fame: The committee presented their nominees for the 2016 Hall of Fame Banquet in June. Michael Webber – Superior, Cedric Harris – Service, Ester Laughlin – Superior Posthumously, Iona Deckman – Service Posthumously. The board voted and agreed with the committee. At the banquet we will have these and the Youth that are starting the Youth Hall of Fame program. They are Rachael Long, April Pugh, Michelle Swaim from past 10 years and Sierra Lewis from present youth program. We will also honor Martin Smith and Don Millitello from 2014 that were unable to attend the 2014 banquet. The committee decided that chicken will be served at the banquet. Tickets will sell for \$27 each. The new inductees will receive a ticket for themselves and one guest on the adults. The youth will receive one ticket for themselves. All others along with board members will pay for tickets. The banquet will be held at the Jackson Center in Huntsville on June 25, 2016. Social hour will begin at 5 PM and dinner will be served at 6 PM. Motion was made by D Millitello and seconded to accept the slate on inductees. Motion passed.

Annual Meeting: Held on June 26, 2016 at Pin Palace at 2:00 PM.

A side note: R Swaim was asked to help work with the centers on a price for the High School Bowling Program for 2016-2017. She put together some figures and presented them to the centers.
