Center Managers/Owners,

Huntsville USBC would like to put the Open/Woman City Tournament back on rotation. Upon doing so we would like for the centers to agree upon a set price of \$10.00 per 3 games which includes taxes. At the end of the rotation we will revisit the amount of lineage to see if there needs to be an increase.

The tournaments are held in conjunction of one another and on the first 3 weekends of November. If a center can not agree to the amount, they will be skipped in the rotation until the following agreement letter is set.
